Recognition

Shri Shivaji Vidya Prasarak Sanstha was established in 1908. Arts, Science and Commerce College was established by this santha in June 1956.

S.S.V.P. Sanstha has grown in to a large educational trust providing multitudinous branches of education catering every kind of needs of students in tune with the modern times. The science faculty was independently started as a separate college in June 1967 and was named as " Late Karmveer Dr. P.R. Ghogrey Science College" in the year 1986-87.

The College name is in the memory of a great visionary in education, Late. Dr. Pandurang Ramchandra Ghogrey.

Initially the college was affiliated to the university of Pune. Now the college is affiliated to KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon,with effect from 15th August 1990.

The college was awarded a " Best college Award" by KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon on 24 Sept. 2005.

The college was also recognized as a 'Star College' by the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India, during 2009.

The college was recognized as a "College with Potential for Excellence" by UGc, New Delhi, during 2006 to 2016.

Recently the college is reaccredited for third cycle with 'A+ Grade' (CGPA:3.55) by NAAC, Banglore.

The courses offered in the college range from under graduate to Ph.D. Programmers and some non traditional career oriented courses on a self finance basis. Today the strength of student's is about 2428 registered for various courses in the college. Many past students of the college hold respectable positions in different walks of life at state/National/International level.

Infrastructure and Learning Resources

The college campus is spread over 35 acres of land. Each department is having separate building and well equipped laboratories. There is a separate quarter for rector in the campus. The campus consists of 45 class rooms, auditorium, three seminar halls, meeting hall, administrative building, ladies room, canteen, cycle stand, N.C.C. office, N.S.S. office, gymnasium and gymkhana, hostels, botanical garden, Poly house along and spacious play ground with mini stadium.



Teaching Faculty

The teaching faculty consists of learned teachers and experts in their subjects discharging their duties. Majority of teachers have acquired Ph. D. and M. Phil. degree as their highest educational qualifications. Fifteen teachers are recognized as Ph.D. / NET / SET / GRF / M.Phil. Guide. Good number of student are working under their guidance. The faculties of the college have published more than 445 research papers and 35 books. Many teachers have undertaken the minor and major research projects funded by the agencies like U.G.C., D.S.T., Self Finance etc.

Library

The library has a beautiful and spacious building. It has a massive collection of 70,000 books including reference books and 105 journals. It is kept open from 10.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m.. For the convenience of students.

A special scheme is provided for issuing books for home reading. Specific days are fixed for students of various classes to fill the demand slips on previous day. Undergraduate students can borrow one book and postgraduate students can borrow two books at a time. The book bank facility is also available for final year U.G. and P.G. students. A set of books is issued for the whole year to those students who had secured more than 80% marks at Board/ University examination.

Hostels

The college has separate hostels for boys and girls, which are situated in the college premises. Accommodation for 100 boys and 200 girl students is available in their respective hostels. Hostel facilities are provided for economically weaker girls and boys from nearby rural area. Seats are reserved for students belonging to S.C. and S.T. category. Mess facility is provided in hostels.

Gymkhana and Gymnasium

Our college pays a special attention to physical education, games and sports. Students are encouraged for sports and athletics, Shooting Features Fange. Special badminton indoor court is open to the students from morning to evening. Table tennis and chess can also be played in gymkhana hall. Play ground with athletics track of 400 meters, ideal ground for cricket, football, hockey and basket ball are the special features of gymkhana.

College has sixteen multistation gymnasium with modern equipments, which are accessible to the students for improving their physical fitness. During last five years, 75 students participated in All India Inter University Tournaments.



National Service Scheme (N.S.S.)

The college has N.S.S. unit consisting of 160 students. The students are expected to dedicate 120 hours for social work and attend a special winter camp during the year. Certificates are awarded to those students who satisfactorily complete the attendance norms.

College N.S.S. unit implements activities like communal harmony, health and hygiene awareness, medical camp in adopted village, adult education, blood donation camp, pollution and AIDS awareness, etc. which help students for their personality development. Our NSS unit secured state level prize in Maharashtra Road safety programme.

Dr.P.N. Mahale the programme officer of our NSS Unit has been awarded university level Best Programme Officer.

National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.)

The college has infantry company for boys attached to 48, Maharashtra Battalion, Dhule. Our college N.C.C. unit enrolls about 54 cadets. There is provision for N.C.C. candidate to join various courses like army attachments, mountaineering for advance leadership etc. Activities in N.C.C. include parade, use of arms, social work and blood donation, etc. This education is extended during regular parades and camps. The candidates passing B and C certificate examinations of N.C.C. have good prospects for the selection in the army and police services. During last two years, **Four cadets participated R.D. Parade, Delhi.** Senior under officer **Rajsimran Cheema** participated in Prime Minister's Rally held at New Delhi and awarded a **Gold Medal and Best Cadet Award**. She also visited China under Youth Exchange Programme.



During last five years, twenty cadets enrolled as Sainik in Indian Armed Forces. Senior under officer **Gurjeet Bhullar** participated R.D. Parade at New Delhi on 26 Jan 2018 and was declared as a **'All India Best Cadet'**. He visited Russia under Youth Exchange Programme.

Personality Development

Extra-curricular activities through various committees such as Arts circle, Debating Committee, Elocution Committee, Yuvati Sabha, Planning Forum, Talent Search Examination, General Knowledge Examination, etc. are regularly organised. Lectures of eminent personalities from various subjects are arranged. These activities provide a platform and opportunities to students for their overall personality development.

College has been providing facility to conduct "Maharashtra Talent Search" exam since 1996.

Students' Council

As per the guidelines of N.M.U., Students' Council is formed every year. A class representative, according to merits, represents each class. This council elects University Representative. Members of students' council play an important role in working of various committees of the college.

Study Tour and Excursions

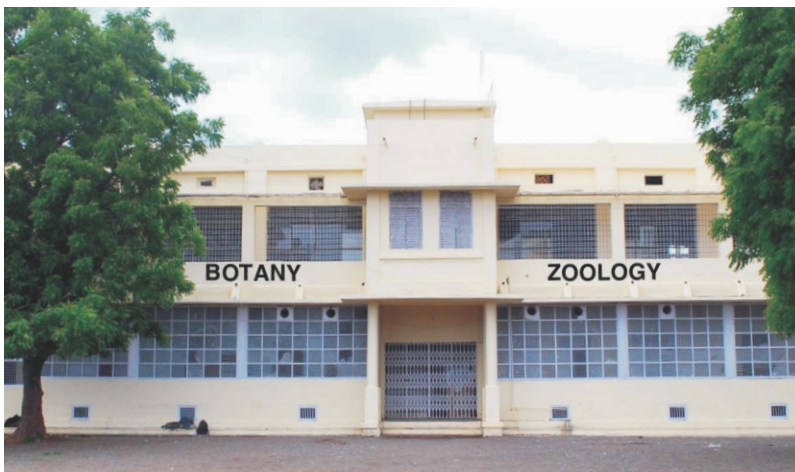
Department wise study tours are arranged every year for the students. Excursions are compulsory for T.Y.B.Sc. and M.Sc students of Botany, Zoology and Geography.

Admission Procedure

A student seeking admission has to submit application in a prescribed form. The applicant should fill in the form carefully. Incomplete or incorrect form will not be accepted.

- * Admission to all classes is made strictly on merit Basis.
- * For admission to F.Y.B.Sc., eligibility form, original mark-sheet, Leaving Certificate and their two attested true copies are necessary. Admission will not be confirmed unless eligibility is obtained from the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The students of S.Y.B.Sc. and T.Y.B.Sc. classes should attach an attested copy of mark sheet of the previous examination to the admission form.
- * Students from other Universities/States are not eligible for admission.
- * Students from other colleges within the jurisdiction of North Maharashtra University must produce T.C. at the time of admission in the college. Such students will have to obtain a written permission from university for the change of college.
- * Normally no change is allowed in the subject once offered by a student. However, any change in the subject can exceptionally be allowed by the Principal only on payment of fees of Rs. 50/- . The last date for allowing the change in subject is notified separately on the Notice Board.
- * No student by right, can claim admission to the college. The Principal can refuse admission to any student without giving any reason.
- * Admission will not be offered on duplicate L. C. or Mark Sheet.

University Eligibility

Every student seeking admission to any graduate or postgraduate course of K.B.C. North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon is required to obtain eligibility from the University.

A student has to apply in a prescribed form and pay the prescribed fees to obtain eligibility.

- 1) Following documents are required to be submitted alongwith the prescribed application form.
 - * Original mark sheet
 - * Migration certificate (for student coming from other University)
 - * Passing certificate
 - * Transfer certificate
- 2) It will be the responsibility of the student to see that his eligibility certificate and other certificates are secured by him from the previous university or college and that they are produced to the college along with eligibility certificate form before the prescribed date.
- 3) If student is unable to receive the eligibility certificate from the university, college will not be responsible for any consequences of non grant of eligibility by the University.

Procedure for Payment of Fees

Following procedure is adopted for payment of fees

- * All payments are to be remitted to the bank by challan. The extension counter of the HDFC bank is situated in the college campus.
- * For such payment every student must fill a challan in quadruplicate and get its counter signed by the concerned clerk.
- * The amount of fees must be paid in the bank on the same day on which the clerk has countersigned the challan.
- * Student should submit part 'C' of challan along with other relevant documents in the office. If the student does not submit his/ her challan in the office, his/ her admission will not be confirmed.
- * College will not be responsible for students who pay fees in Cash to any third party.

Refund of Fees (for under graduate courses only)

Refund of fees shall be as under vide circular No 126/ 2003 and 143/2003 from KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.

- * There will be no deduction in fees if student lives the college within 15 days from the date of his/ her admission.
- * There will be 20% deduction in total fees (except the tuition fee) if student leaves the college within the day 16th to day 30th from the date of his/her admission.
- * No student can claim refund of any type of fees if he/ she leaves the college after 30 days from the date of his/ her admission in the college. However balance of total fees due shall be recovered from such student.

Attendance and Disciplinary Rules

1. 80% attendance of total number of days in each term is necessary to enable a student to be admitted to University examination. (NMU ordinance No. 65 to 73)
2. A day's attendance means attendance at all lectures and practicals prescribed in the college time table for the class in which the student is studying.
3. Satisfactory attendance means attendance on all days on which the college is functioning except when leave of absence has been previously granted by the Principal.
4. Student shall abide by all the general and special rules framed by the college authorities from time to time in regard to their conduct and studies.
5. Student should not remain absent for lectures and practicals without proper cause and an application for leave of absence must be submitted to the concerned committee.
6. Use of apron is compulsory for M.Sc. in Chemistry, Microbiology. & Biotechnology students.
7. No student will be allowed to take active part in any political activity directly or indirectly associated with antisocial movement or any activity with the aim of violence.
8. Any Student should not in any way disfigure the premises of the college and the hostel building or tempered with furniture, electric connections, laboratory apparatus etc.
9. Every student must obtain college identity card within a week from the date of admission and he/she must have college identity card with him/her at all times in the college premises. If an identity card is lost students can get new identity card by paying fees of Rs.30.
10. Smoking/Consuming drugs, narcotics, tobacco, gutkha in college premises is strictly prohibited. Not only this, if a student is found in possession of narcotics and/ or drugs he will be liable for punishment under Mumbai police act 1951.
11. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college campus and hostels. The student involved in ragging will be punished by cancellation of his/her admission & disciplinary action against him.
12. Tour should not be arranged without pre permission of the Principal.
13. College authorities will take disciplinary action against students for their misbehaviour.
14. The use of mobile in the college premises is strictly prohibited.
15. Identity Card and Uniform is compulsorily while in campus.
